- ❑ We made kit bags filled with small objects and items that would please them. When they saw their kit bags, they immediately stopped crying and played for over an hour without acknowledging their pain. Thus the vision was borne – the ability to bring a child in need into a world of love, compassion and understanding even if momentarily pain free.
- ❑ We prayed for this to become a reality some day for all our spiritual children. In 2001 the vision became a reality. It is possible and we have seen the evidence alive and God blessed the vision.
- ❑ With the help and thanks of the CBM, CIL and ALS they saw the need and endorsed the fund giving it credibility. Come, join up and share the vision with us and see the reality of its' effect on both the lives of the children and our lives as ecclesias, as brothers & sisters, as dear children. 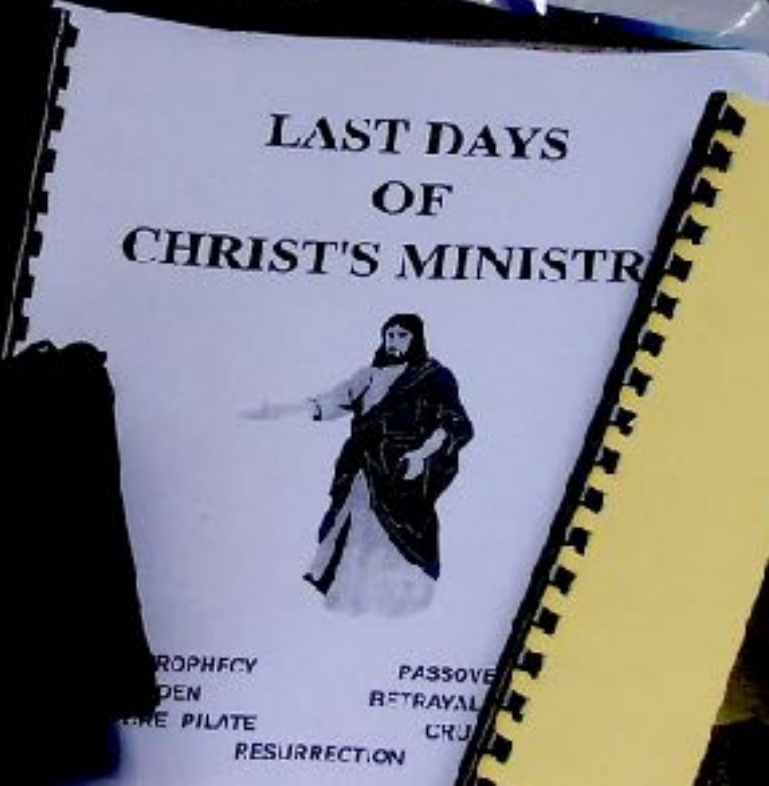

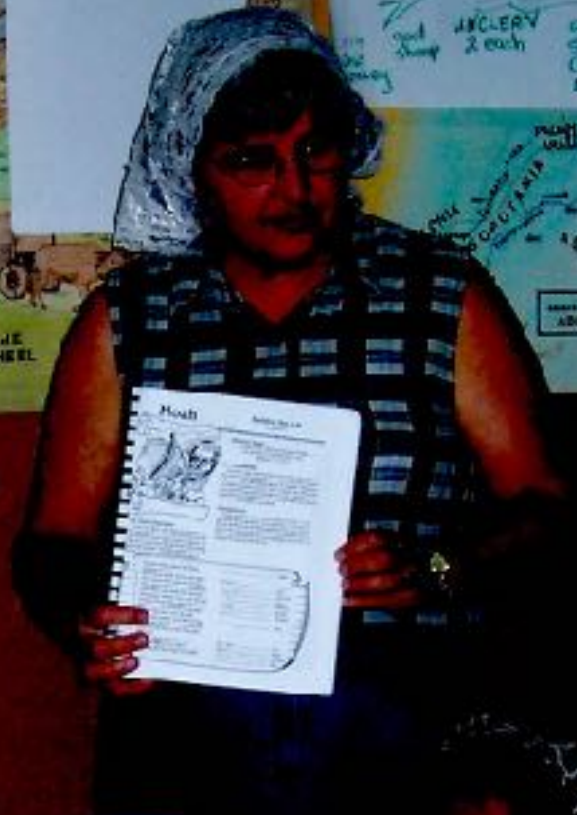

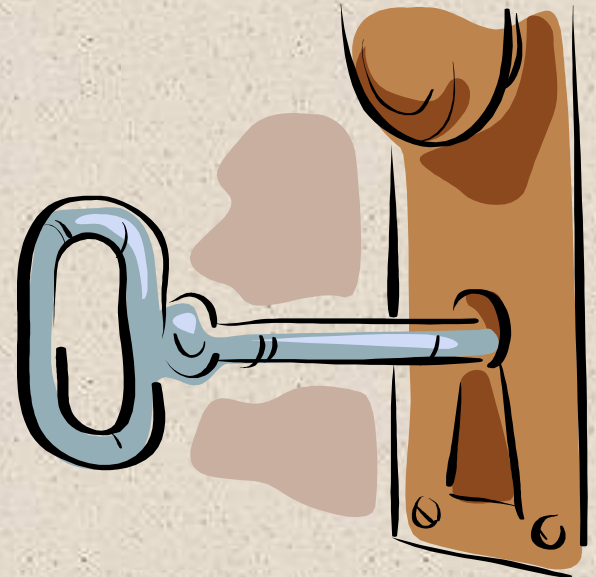
INTERNATIONAL CONNECTION

TANZANIA → LONDON

WHILE TEACHING SUNDAY SCHOOL TO NEW AFRICAN REFUGEE CHILDREN IN LONDON, ONTARIO, ONE CHILD "SELE" ASKED ME, "AUNT WEEZIE, DID YOU EVER SEND SUPPLIES TO TANZANIA?" I SAID "YES, WHY?". SHE REPLIED THAT SHE RECEIVED A KIT AND DESCRIBED IT PERFECTLY. WHILE SHOPPING AT THE CSTCF HOUSE WAS A COMMON OCCURANCE WITH MY NEW 7 SUNDAY SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM TANZANIA, THE COMMAND WHEN FORTH FROM "SELE" THAT THE CHILDREN NOW HAD TO UNDERSTAND THAT "NEEDY CHILDREN GET THESE SUPPLIES AND WE DON'T NEED THEM UNLESS AUNTIE WEEZIE SAYS SO", THUS THE SHOPPING EVENTS BECAME LESS AND LESS FREQUENT. THEY CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD THE VALUE OF GIVING AND RECEIVING AND THE LESSON THAT IT IS "BETTER TO GIVE THAN TO RECEIVE". SUCH IS THE WORLDWIDE CONNECTION AND ONE NEVER KNOWS WHEN GOD CONNECTS THE DOTS.

Enjoying temporary respite and fellowship in Wales Youth Camp

Our experience at the Christadelphian Llancamp, Wales August 2012

On August the 11th, Sabrina and I, two 14 years old girls from Israel went to Llancamp for a week – and it was definitely an experience for us to remember! This time, we arrived to Britain alone and it was our first time traveling by plane without adults but we managed. Chris Brook, our uncle Chris whom we know for several years already, met us at the airport and we spent some days with him and his wife Judy. Immediately we remembered our visit to this lovely family in 2010. This time, we visited a zoo, looked around Birmingham. We enjoyed very much the Bible readings with very interesting discussions in the evening. We used two Bible versions – Hebrew and English and this gave us even more experience. Then we went to the camp. It took about four hours on a coach but we had a stop for a break and to eat lunch. Although we know three languages: Hebrew, Russian and English, there are still not enough words to describe how camping feels: The sleeping in the sleeping bags, walking in the mud, the dish washes and of course complaining about the rain. But despite all this, camp is a wonderful place to meet friends, enjoy the beautiful nature and of course to get close to God and Jesus. We had interesting Bible study for the week. Camp is lots of tents in the field by the sea. It is beautiful. There is a very big tent called a marquee, which has electric lights. We were happy to meet some of our old friends that we met in 2010. We enjoyed almost all the activities except the morning sea swim but the difference in temperature between the sea around Llan and the Israeli Mediterranean is shocking. Llancamp is definitely a place we would like to visit again. I understand that there were many people, the Christadelphians like my mother and father, who helped us to visit this camp and both Sabrina and I would like to thank these people very much.
